

## *2021 District Softball Tournament*

- 1) Each school needs to provide three softballs.
- 2) Higher seed is the home team and will use the third base dugout. Home team is the official book. The number 1 seed will get to determine which field they want to play on (North or South). If top seed wins they will stay put and other teams will move accordingly.
- 3) The 15- run rule after three innings and 10- run rule after five innings will be in effect.
- 4) There will be no time limit.
- 5) Buses are to park in the alley-way on the North side of the softball fields. Buses should come in to Genesee on Chestnut (the main street off the highway exit) and then turn RIGHT onto Krier Rd, which is just before the fire station. Buses will turn left onto the alley way just past the car wash and before the SB fields. We want to keep this a one way road to make it easy for loading and unloading of buses.
- 6) Gate receipts will pay for the umpires, tournament manager's fee, school stipend and additional expenses. The Whitepine League will pick up any uncovered costs. Any profits will stay in the WPL account.
- 7) The Whitepine League first place trophy will be presented prior to the recipient's first tournament game. The District II 1-A Tournament trophy for first place will be presented following the championship game.
- 8) Admission Prices are: Adults \$6.00, Seniors \$5.00, Students 7-12 \$5.00, Students K-6 \$4.00, Pre-School – no charge, IHSAA passes will be honored. Gate will be charged upon entrance to the fields whether walking or driving in to the fields. People with physical limitations may be driven into the park and dropped off, and pay as they enter the park. There will also be handicap parking spots designated for use as well.
- 9) There will be concession items for sale, and there is also a grocery store a block away.
